Guadalupe is a delightful town in the Cáceres district known as Las Villuercas, a lovely village with cobbled streets and houses built in the traditional vernacular style. It is home to an extremely valuable area of artistic and historical importance dating from the 15th and 16th centuries. It has been preserved with its original structure intact, making you feel as if you are on a film set. Santa Maria Square, where the Parador is located, and the old Jewish quarter are well worth a leisurely visit. From here you can travel to mountain villages in the surrounding area, including Cañamero, Logrosán and Berzocana. Another of the region's attractions is the delicious Extremaduran cuisine.

The Parador is specialised in the culture of cheese and is a member of the Route of Extremadura Cheese. Not only that, but it has other local gastronomic offerings such as the unique Spanish Black pudding, migas (fried breadcrumb dish), various types of gazpacho, stews, stewed potatoes, Torta del Casar and Barros which are cheeses made with the milk of goats from the Ibores region.
