The Castle was the scene for the battle fought by King Afonso Henriques against the Moors, in the 12th century.

Inhabited since pre-historical ages, Palmela is a town characterized by the legacy of different cultures.

Between the 8th and the 12th century, the territory was occupied by Moors, until it was conquered by King Afonso Henriques.

Palmela is inseparable from the castle: it hosted the monks of the Santiago de Espada convent and was chosen by the Military Order as its venue.

Although Palmela is part of Lisbon's Metropolitan Area, it not only includes the Costa Azul (Blue Coast) – an area of very beautiful and heterogeneous beaches – such as the Natural Reserve of Estuário do Sado, but also the admirable Serra da Arrábida Natural Park.

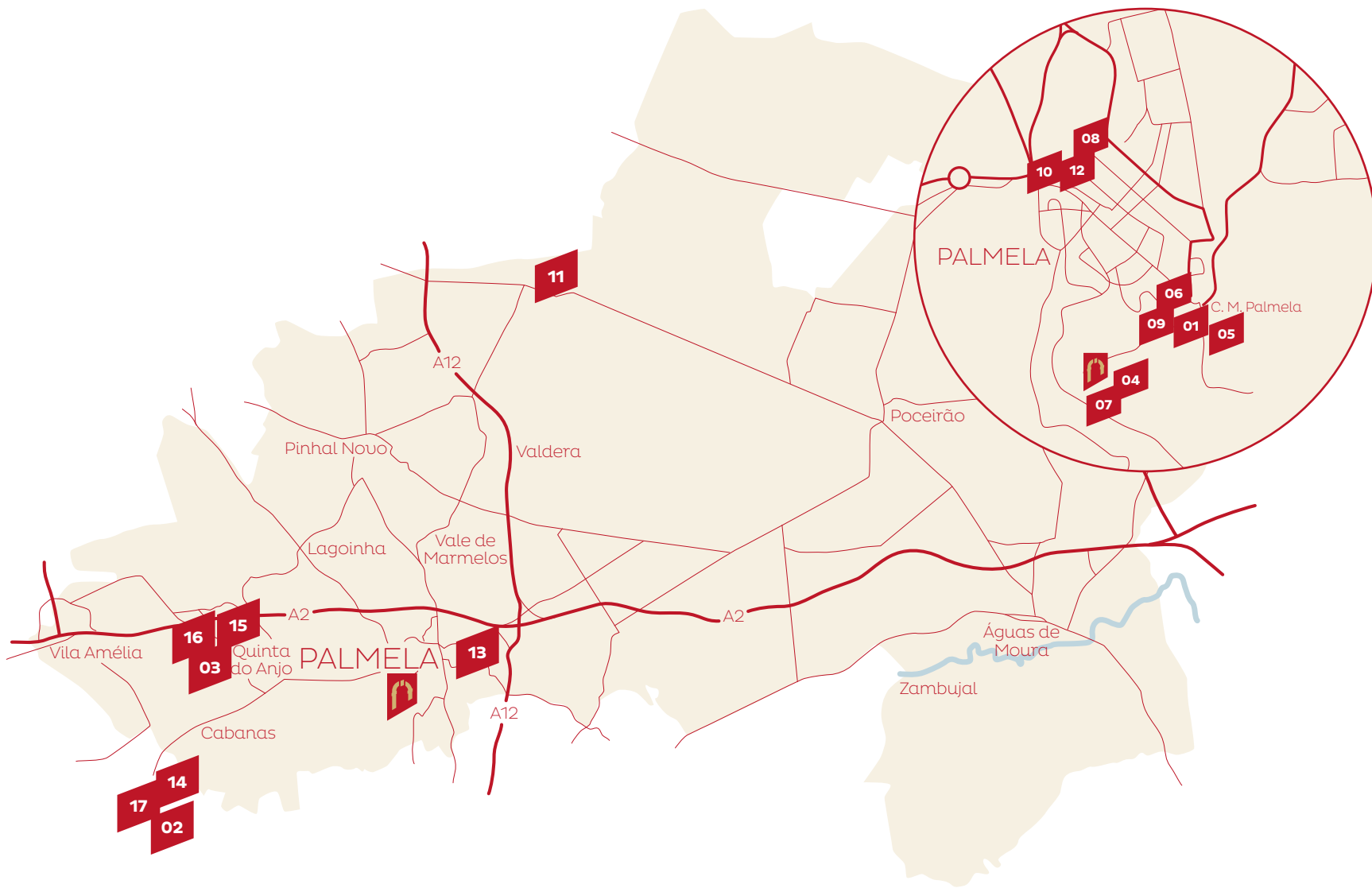

TO SEE

Palmela developed towards the north around the hill on which the Castle is located. But in addition to a picturesque town with typical streets and great serenity, it is a city strongly marked by history with a unique surrounding landscape. Walking through its historic centre, churches serve as its main attraction. In the surroundings, visitors can discover the artificial caverns of “Quinta do Anjo” and the Rio Frio Estate and Palace. In the context of an enological route, it is worth visiting: Casa Agrícola Horácio Simões, “Venâncio da Costa Lima” – home that received, in 2012, the outstanding award for “Best Muscatel in the World”, “Quinta da Bacalhoa”, José Maria da Fonseca and the Palmela Cooperative Cellar.

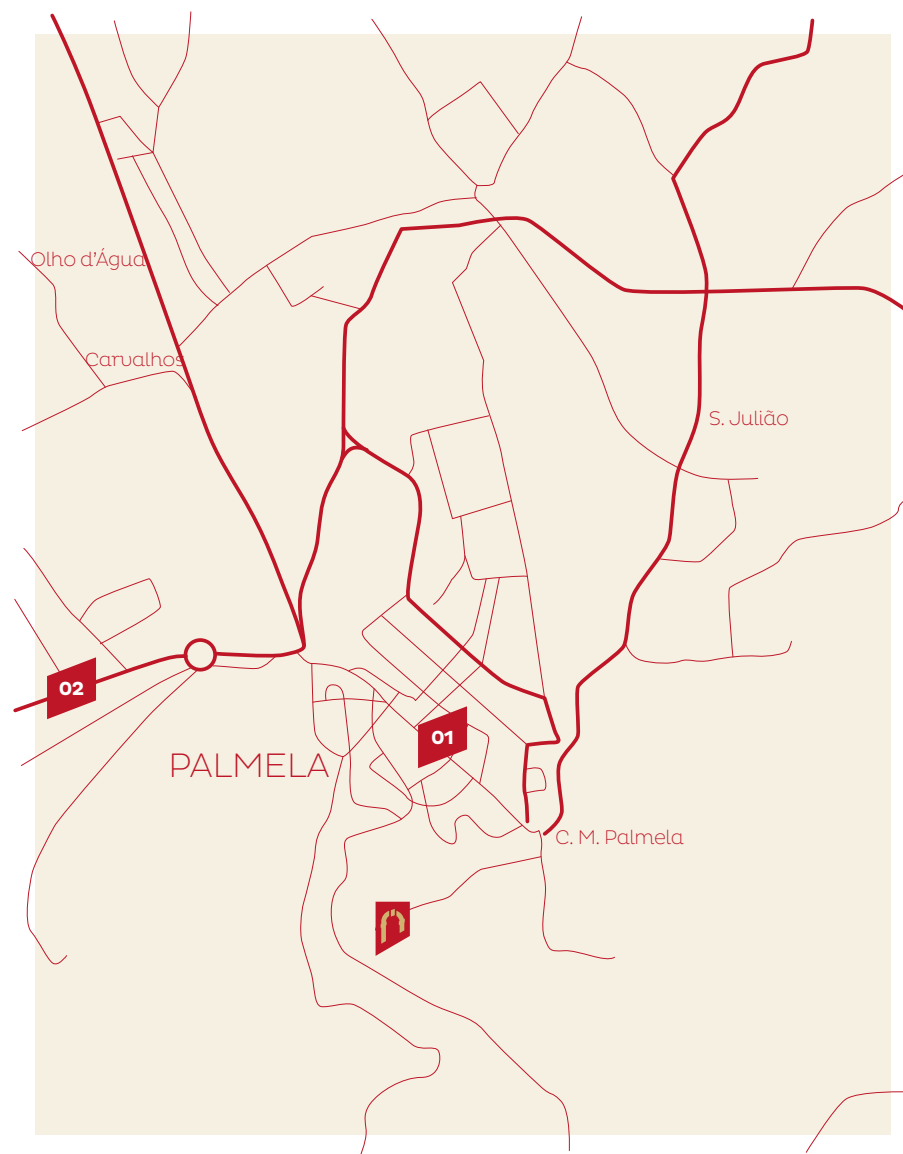

TO EAT

Palmela represents a mixture of gastronomic influences, with Alentejo, Ribatejo and port influences due to its proximity to the port of Setúbal. As main dishes, we have the Hare with Beans Palmela Style, the Cozido capado pot and the Beans Caramela style. Among the desserts, we have the Fogaça de Palmela or the Santiago cakes or the pear cooked in Muscatel wine. Speaking of which, we cannot talk about Palmela without mentioning its fabulous wines: as a region of wine production, it was declared European Wine City in 2012. Start out discovering these flavours and end the day at a restaurant of the Costa Azul to enjoy the sunset.
