Enjoy your stay in the castle of Óbidos, one of the 7 wonders of Portugal and one of the most emblematic and inspiring villages to travel back in time to, from the time of the conquest of D. Afonso Henriques in 1148 until the establishment of this space as dowry for the queens of Portugal, with the marriage of King Dinis.

Let yourself be inspired by the village that you see in the distance, protected between walls, with its whitewashed houses and colorful gardens. This is a safe and inviting, hidden and attractive, flashy and insidious site, which tells you, simultaneously, that you must strive to conquer it, without ever stopping wanting to please you.

If you stay in the Casa do Castelo, you'll have a closer feel for what it is to live in this village, so protected and quiet. Put comfortable shoes on and dare to go through the wall that protects the village. Let your eyes get lost in the sandy areas, today cultivated fields and into the sea, further out. Identify the church towers and rooftops of this peculiar village and take note: is anything missing? There aren't antennas in this village that refuses to show that time did not stop nor wait for it, despite finding all the comforts of today in the interiors.

ROOMS

All rooms are named after a king or queen who has been here and you can learn more about its unique history through the QR Codes that you can find at the entrance of all rooms. And given the unique features of this remarkable area, of course all are different, with classical and medieval decoration or more current and contemporary style, but always extremely comfortable. After all, a journey in time does not have to be a historical recreation and the soft beds, the fluffy pillows and air conditioning are sure to help make it more friendly.

MEDIEVAL SCENARIO FOR EXTRAORDINARY MEALS

The only thing that overcomes the fact that you are spending a few days in a unique and inspiring national monument, is living dining experiences that put the icing on the cake, or in this particular case, since we are talking about Óbidos, the cherry at the bottom of the cup. This restaurant, with fabulous views, high ceilings and the wood text, well prepared tables and comfortable armchairs, invites you to spend time to taste the dishes with inspiration from the West!

Reserve the special moon table, more discreet and quiet for a more private conversation and a unique view of the Senhor da Pedra Church; or the twilight table for a particularly romantic dinner in the summer! There are also tables with a privileged view from the Manueline windows, that will make you feel like the most important person of the court. The original tiles with birds and fish designs, the coppers and the dishes help you walk a few centuries back in time when the world seemed to spin slower.

All dishes come covered with a hood, which increases the expectation of what you will taste and the sophistication of the service. Feel treated like a king or queen, in this so special castle.

SPECIALITIES

Fresh scallops sautéed with thyme, apple puree and fresh cress

Fried codfish loin, with stewed onions, fresh tomato and sliced fried potatoes

Grilled bass from the west coast, potatoes and fresh vegetables, with butter and lemon sauce

Stewed chicken from the fields in a clay pot with potatoes, pearl onions, mustard, little slices of bacon and fresh tomato. Recipe from 1960, Alcobaça

Roasted “Royal Duck” breast, lacquered with honey lime and natural orange juice, raisins and dried figs on mashed potatoes

Regional dessert from Caldas da Rainha, “Trouxas-de-ovos” elaborated according to ancestral traditions with fresh pineapple and mint leaf. Recipe from the XV century

Pears from the West of Portugal boiled in regional wine and the regional liqueur “ginja”. Recipe from the XV century

Traditional tartlet filled with egg yolks, sugar and sweet pumpkin & Traditional cake from Leiria with almond, egg yolks, sugar and eggs. Recipe's from the XV century

Óbidos is one of the best examples of medieval architecture preserved in Portugal.

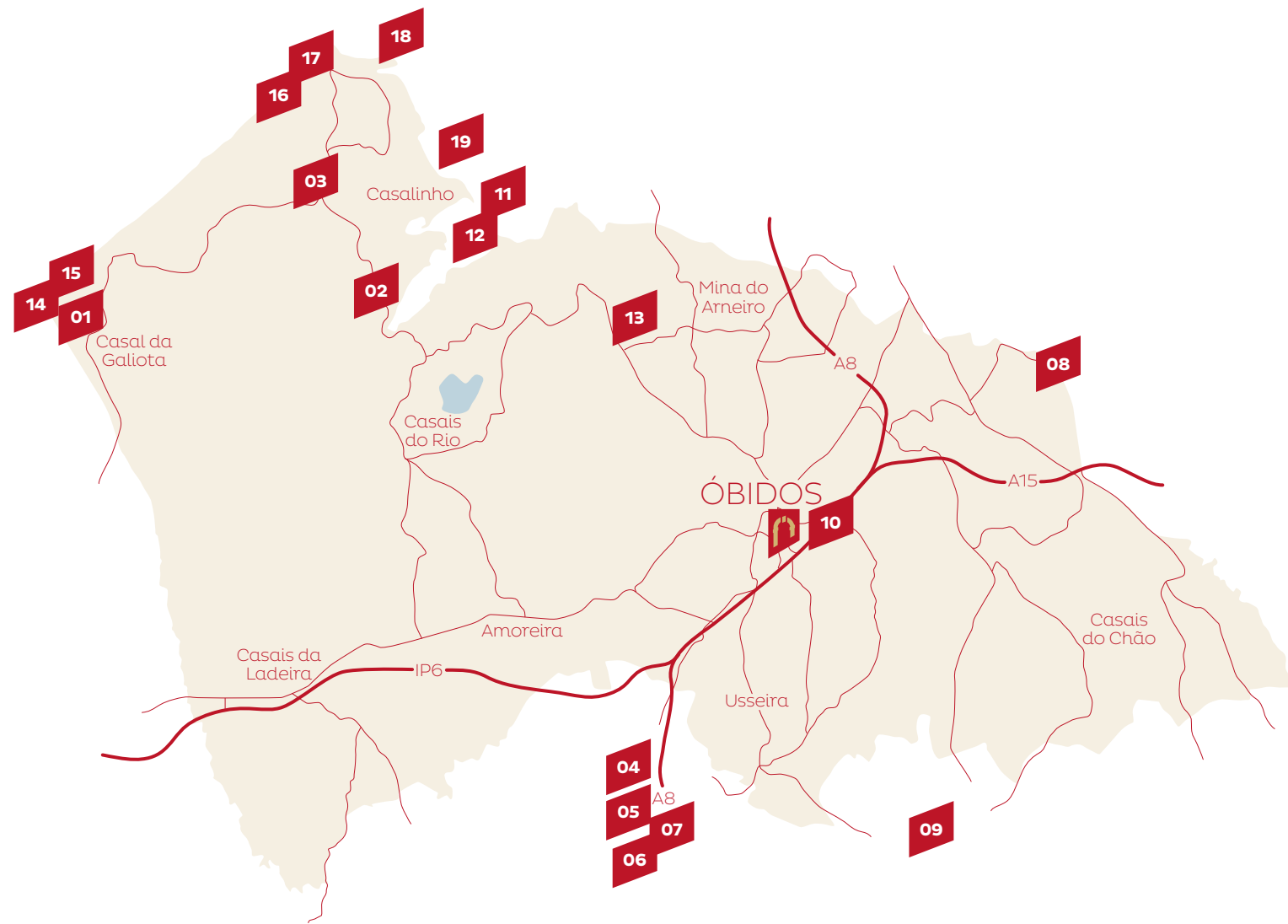
OUT

The village of Óbidos was conquered from the Moors in 1148 by King Afonso Henriques, but it was not until the beginning of the 16th century that Óbidos gained the Manueline traces for which it is known. This was the work of its Major, João de Dijon.

The cultural treasures hidden in this small village are endless — including 14 churches and chapels — and among these, the Church of St. Mary, covered by the typical glazed tiles and pictures painted by Josefa de Ayalla y Cabrera (Josefa de Óbidos).

Its surroundings are also full of interesting spots, like the aqueduct ordered by D. Catarina of Austria, the wife of King João III, and the Lagoon of Óbidos, the right spot for fishing and hunting, close to the site where royal picnics took place.

And if the historical environment has not completely won over you, wait until you discover the delicious gastronomy.

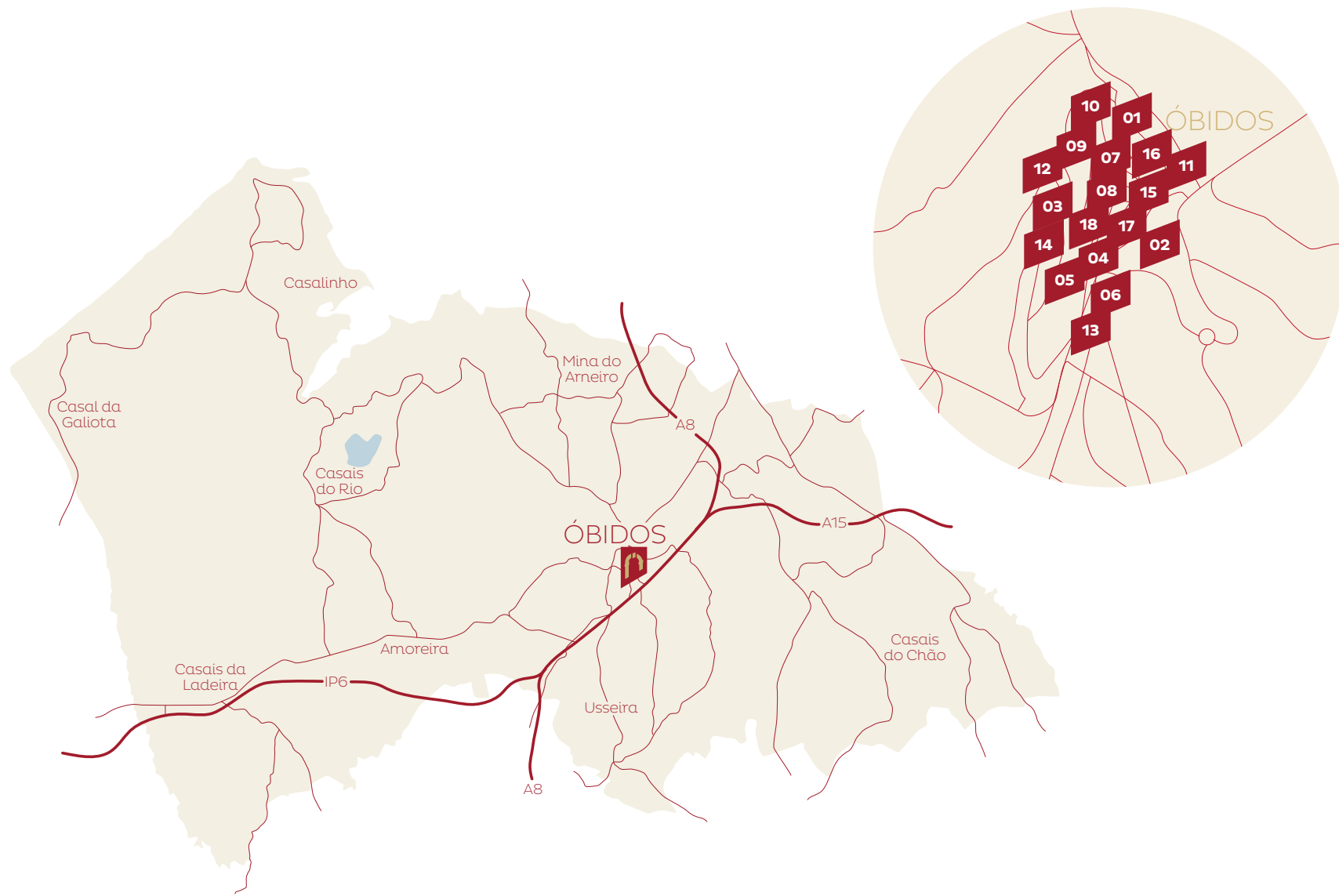

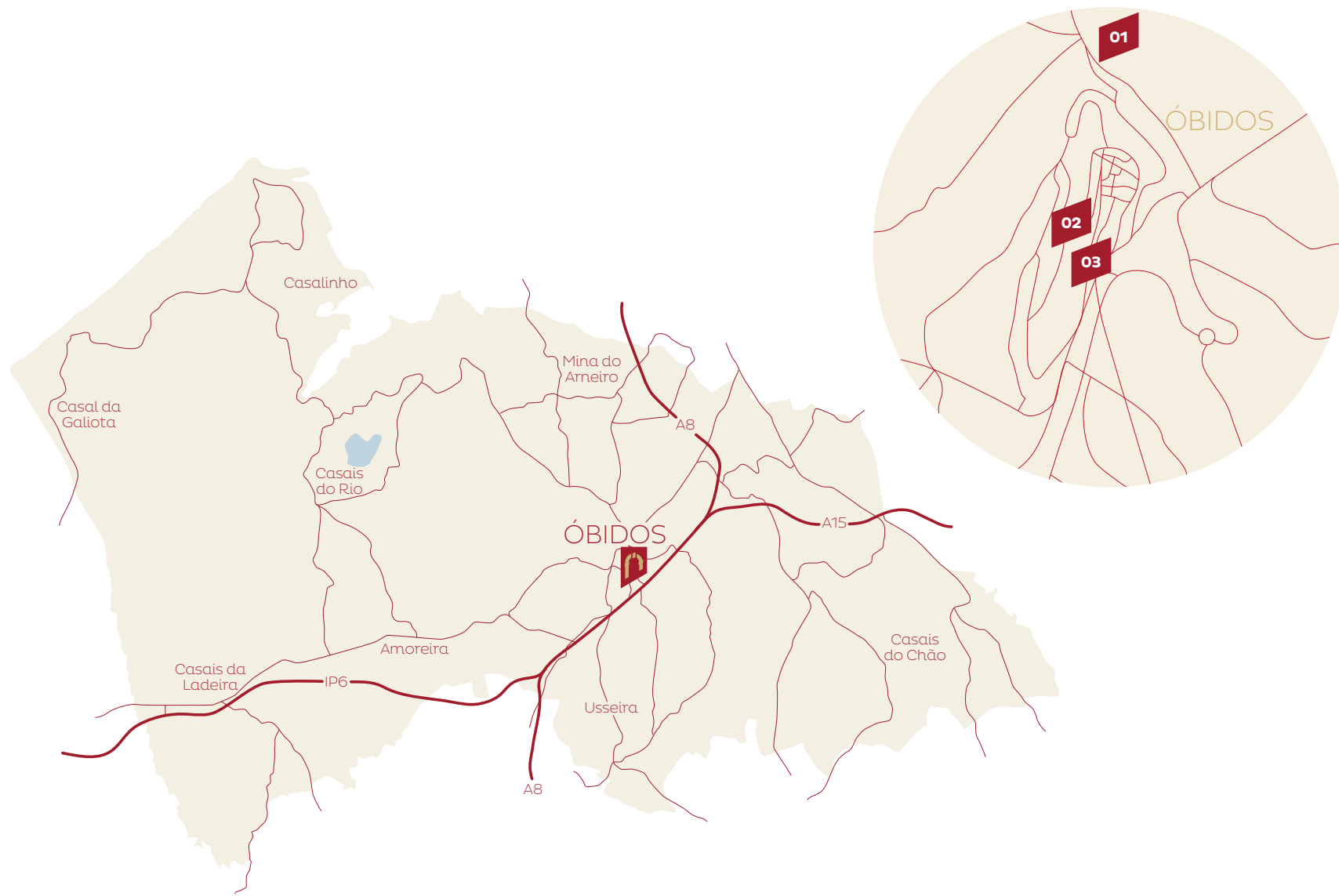
