Submerge yourself in the history of this Pousada Mosteiro do Crato, essential at the time of the Conquest of Portugal from the Moors, who later became home of Dom Álvaro Gonçalves Pereira, father of D. Nuno Álvares Pereira, the constable saint. The monastery foundations were made in 1350, only to be completed 20 years later. In the twentieth century was done the intervention that allows you to be here today, appreciating this witness of the early history of Portugal: the work of recovery of the warrior enigma, monastic and palatial, in the words of the architect Carrilho da Graça, that gives a unique environment to the stay.

The room where you can sit comfortably to read was the old cafeteria of the monastery - if you notice, when arriving, the reception is in the area of the old fireplace, whose mouth is perfectly identifiable. Take as much time as you need to orient yourself in this building, where the old wing and the new wing are joined seamlessly on the inside and clearly on the outside. There are numerous places to discover, stairs to climb, windows, cracks and spaces to peek.

Feel like the protector of a unique site: this Pestana Monument Hotel is the space where you will be able to find walls that are over 600 years old and a modern swimming pool with clean lines, a waterfall and olive trees shade where you can drink a cocktail.



Flor da Rosa has been chronicled as a “Forte Casa” (Strong House), thus raising doubts on its real functions as a monastery.

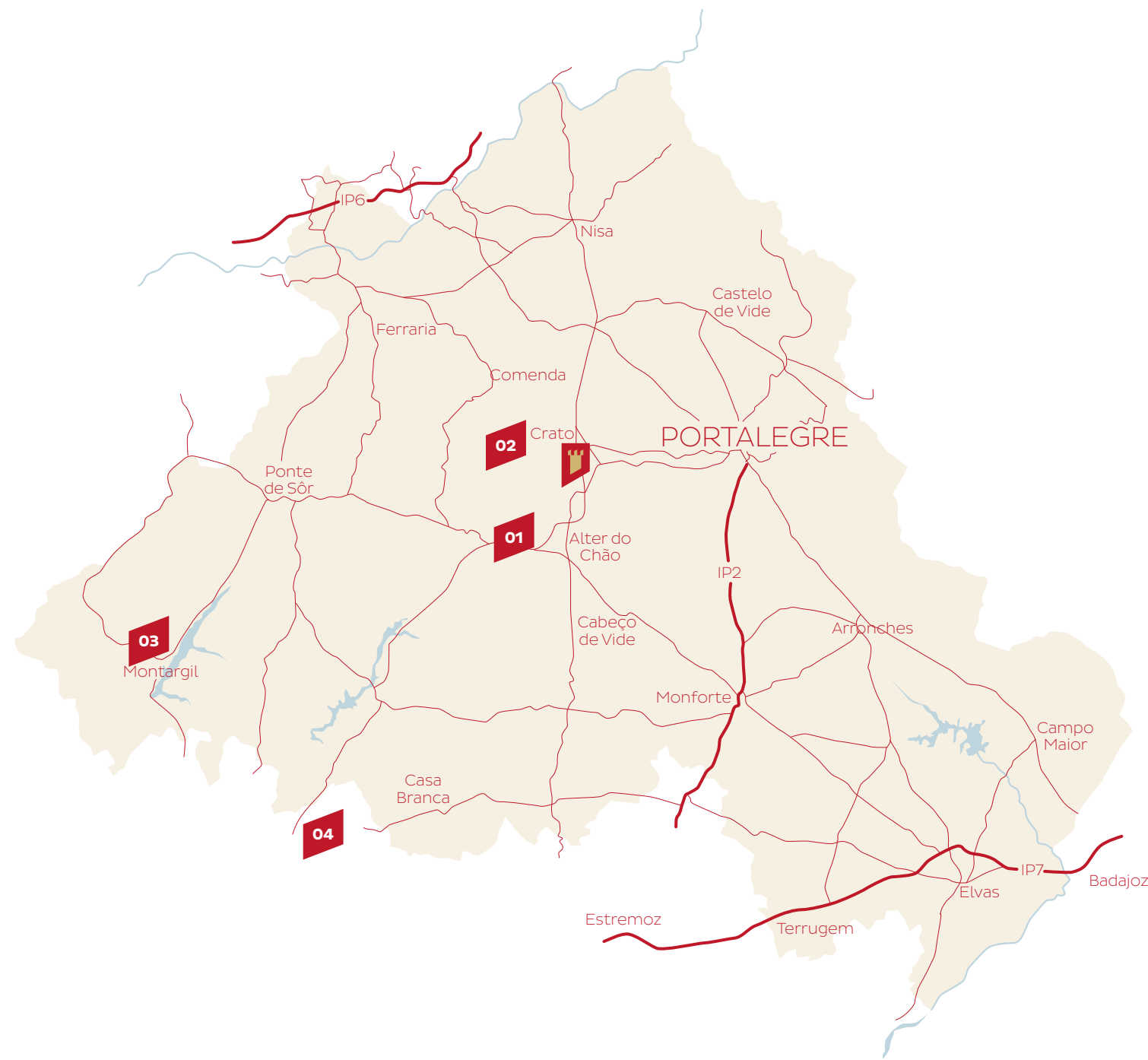

Located 22Km away from Portalegre and benefitting from the typical and natural quiet of Alentejo, Crato is a village full of history and customs that are well reflected in its heritage. The striking presence of megalithic constructions immediately calls the attention to those visiting the region. The villages and bridges testify the Roman occupation. We can find the glamour characteristic from the Baroque style present in many buildings and palaces and the Pousada building testifies the presence of the “Ordem dos Hospitalários” becoming the village’s icon.

In addition to the large number of churches and chapels, the surroundings of Vila do Crato are blessed with a very beautiful natural landscape wherever you look.

TO DO

Tennis and horse riding are only two of many sports one can practice in this inland village. The sea is 220Km away, but the Montargil Reservoir is very close, offering an excellent alternative for a day with the family. If you prefer to stay at Crato, the Water Park is another excellent option.

Although the Alentejo constitutes an invitation to laziness and "dolce fare niente", one of the most complete activities for getting to know the region well are the Thematic Routes, with specific paths focusing on gastronomy as well as on viticulture or the historic tradition of Megalithic times.

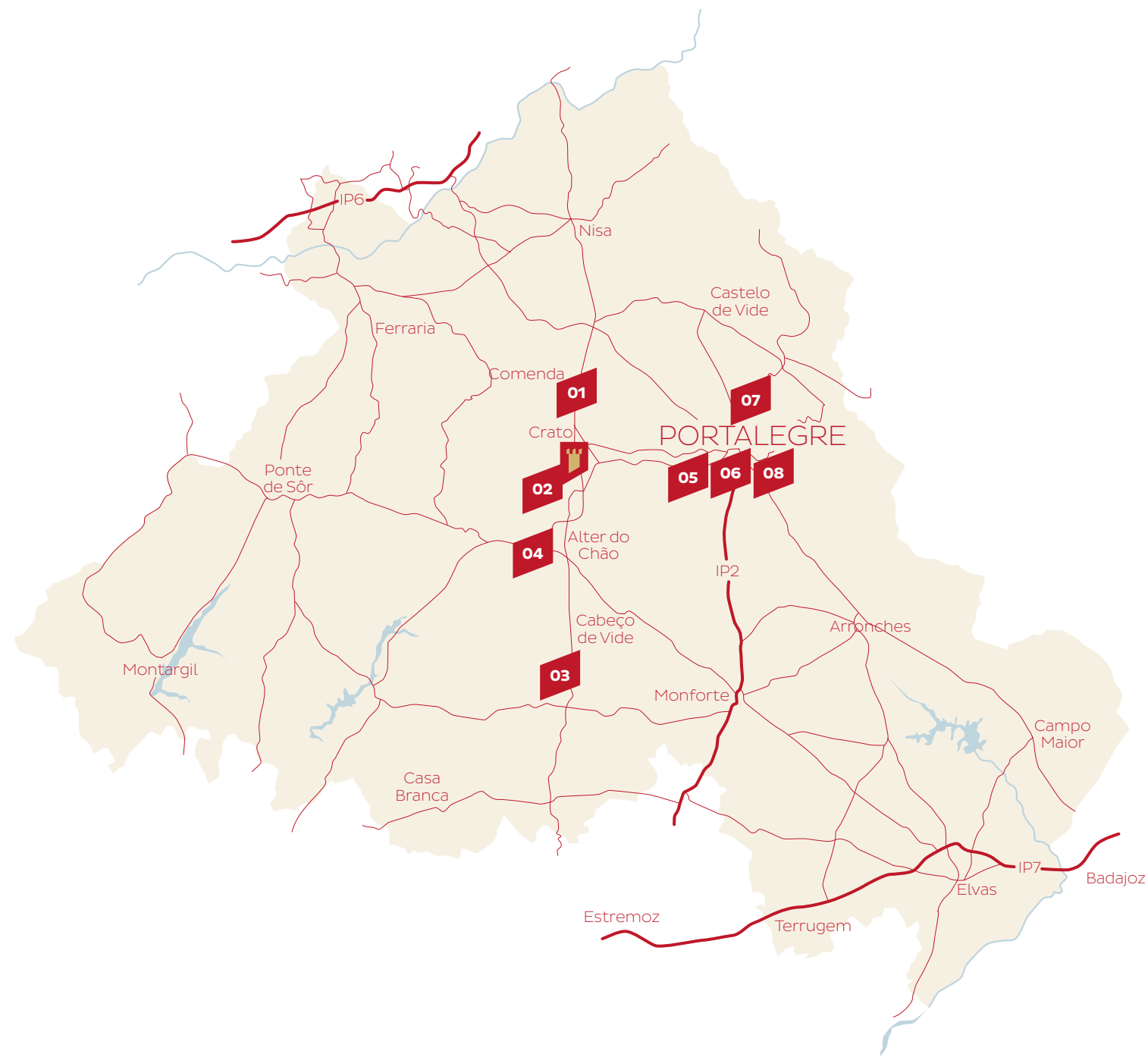

The experience of discovery begins as soon as you arrive at the Pousada. The Monastery of Santa Maria da Flor da Rosa is one of the most emblematic buildings in the region and one of the most original buildings of Portuguese Gothic. It concentrates three periods in its construction and offers a remarkable Museum Centre.

In the village, there is an almost endless number of churches to visit, and you should certainly not miss visiting the Padre Belo House Museum and the Grão Pinto do Crato Balcony. In Portalegre, the capital of this district, take the opportunity to visit the Tapestry Museum and the José Régio House-Museum.

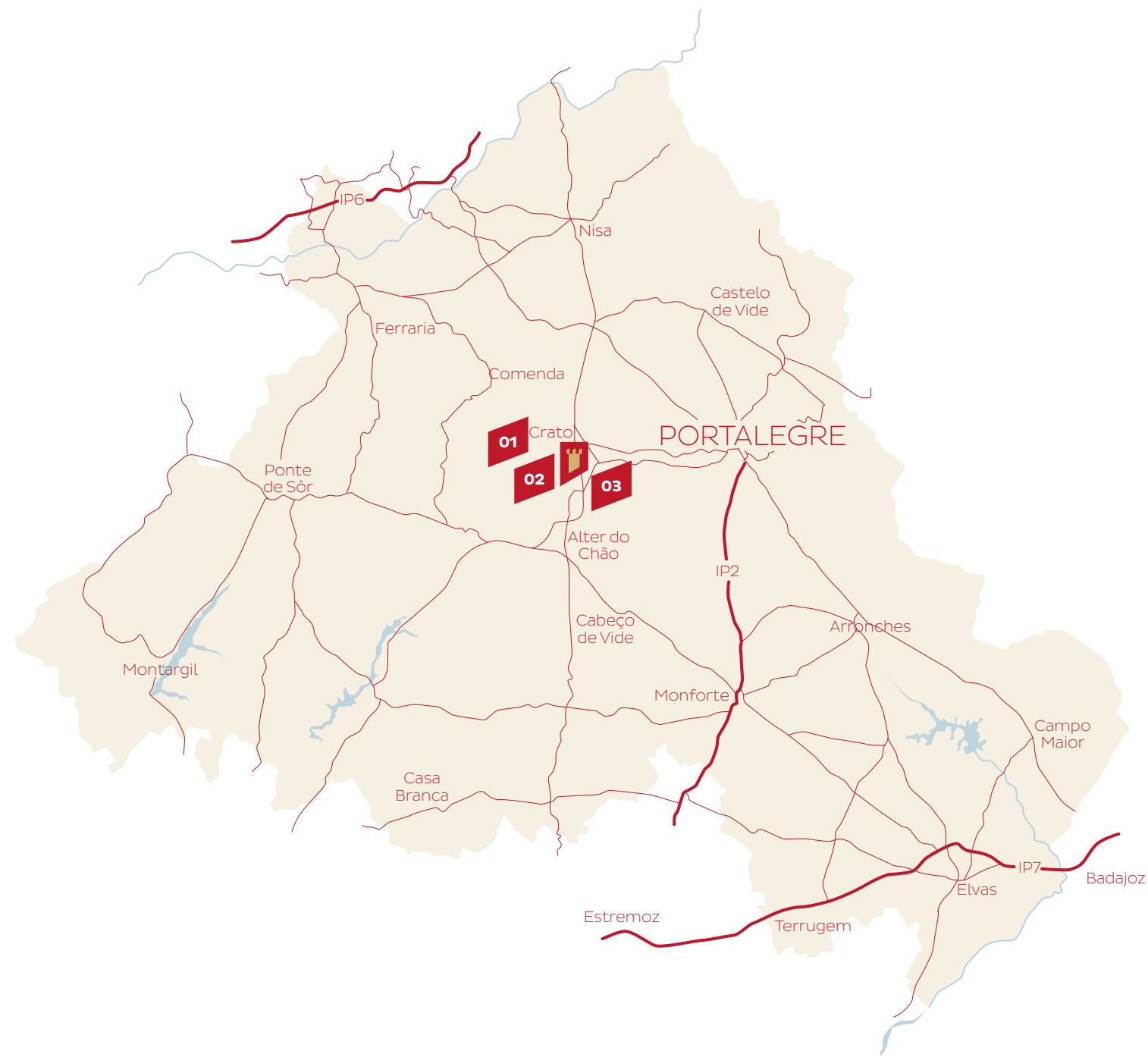
